<u>'100 CLUB LOTTERY'</u> information and rules

For a payment of £5 each month, you will be entered into a draw with 99 fellow members of the Lee Memorial Hall 100 Club. Each monthly draw will have the following prizes (but see also note 8):

First prize of £100, 2 prizes of £50 and 2 prizes of £25.

The Lottery will be limited to 100 members, but, again, please see note 8. For the modest contribution of £5 a month you will not only be supporting the restoration, maintenance and upkeep of the village hall but also giving yourself the chance of winning one (or more) of 5 cash prizes every month – that's odds of 1 in 20, very much better than the national lottery!

All you have to do is complete the attached application form authorising payment by standing order of either £5 each month or £15 every third month or £60 each year.

The Rules of the Lottery are as follows:

- 1. The "100 Club" will operate under The Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976, Section 4, Private Lotteries. The promoter will be the Chairman of Memorial Hall Lee CIO. Memorial Hall Lee CIO reserves the right to amend the rules of the "100 Club" from time to time, as may be necessary. A copy of the current rules will be available from the Chairman or Treasurer of Memorial Hall Lee CIO.
- 2. All profits made by the "100 Club" will be used by Memorial Hall Lee CIO to run, restore and maintain the Memorial Hall.
- 3. The Lottery will be limited to 100 members over the age of 16 years, except as described in section 8.
- 4. The subscription will be £5 per month, payable by standing order either monthly of £5 on the 1st day of each month, or quarterly of £15 on the 1st day of every third month, or annually of £60 on the anniversary of the first payment. On receipt of a standing order form, the applicant will be allocated a Draw Number. For each additional £5 paid per month an additional Draw Number will be allocated.

- 5. Commencing on 26th April 2010, a draw will take place close to the 26th day of every month for cash prizes. Winners of prizes will be notified by post, and the results of the draws will be available by contacting the Chairman or Treasurer of the Memorial Hall Lee CIO. Results will also be available on the website www.leememorialhall.co.uk and will be displayed in the notice boards in Lee and Lincombe.
- 6. 50% of the total annual subscriptions will be paid out in the form of cash prizes; for this purpose, the Club "year" will run from 1st April to 31st March.
- 7. The draws will be conducted by 3 people, one of whom will be the Chairman of the Memorial Hall Lee CIO. Any member of the Club is welcome to attend the draw by contacting the Chairman or Treasurer of the Memorial Hall Lee CIO by the 24th day of the month.
- 8. In the event of there being less than 100 participants, prizes shall be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of members at the time of the draw. In the event of the lottery being oversubscribed, it may be decided to increase the membership number. In this case, the payout will remain at 50% of the income but the numbers of prizes will be increased proportionately; the odds of winning will remain the same.
- 9. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Promoters. Any decision by the Society to wind up the Club will also be by one month's written notice. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded.
- 10. No "100 Club" participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received by the 5th working day of the month in which the draw is taking place. The Promoters reserve the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received on time.
- 11. Prizes will be paid only to the person holding the winning number either by cheque sent through the post or by BACS transfer to their account.
